GLEN ELLYN IS LOCATED 22 MILES WEST OF CHICAGO'S LOOP AT THE GEOGRAPHIC CENTER OF DUPAGE COUNTY.

METRA COMMUTER TRAINS

One of the busiest commuter rail stations on the West Line – it is a 36 minute trip to and from the Loop with 1,665 boardings and 1,629 alightings. Suburban PACE buses service travelers from neighboring communities.

MAJOR AUTOMOTIVE ARTERIES SERVING GLEN ELLYN

East-West

ILLINOIS PRAIRIE PATH

The regional Illinois Prairie Path runs parallel to the Metra/Union Pacific rail line. This recreational path links Glen Ellyn with its east-west neighbors and brings bicycle and pedestrian traffic through the downtown business district with immediate proximity to shops, restaurants and services.

O'Hare International Airport

(20 miles northeast, 30-45 minutes)

Midway Airport

(24 miles southeast, 45 minutes)

DuPage Airport

(general aviation, 15 minutes west)
